This agreement contains the terms and conditions by which Holidayze (a division of Five Star, Inc.) 810 Belmar Plaza, Belmar, NJ, 07719 ("Operator") in considerations for a Participant's payment, agrees to provide these travel tours. **READ AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SENDING ANY MONEY.**

TOUR PRICES: All rates are based on tariffs in effect as of the date of printing. The airfares, if included, used for the tour prices indicated herein are capacity controlled and will be applicable on a "first come, first served" basis and are subject to change without notice.

DEPOSITS: A deposit of \$500.00 is required to guarantee space. 2nd deposit of \$500. is due Sep. 20, 20109. Final payment is due January 02, 2011

PAYMENT: If payment is made by credit card: (1) a signed, fully completed credit card voucher for such payment, with proper authorization, must be received to secure reservations and (2) Participant(s) waive any charge back rights for services provided but not utilized. In the event of a dispute, requests for refunds must be made under the procedure described below under

Cancellations and Refund Policy: Any other person or entity who receives moneys from the Participant(s) does so strictly as an agent for the Participant(s). The Operator disclaims liability for such moneys until received by the Operator's office and confirmation is issued by the Operator. Tender of a deposit constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions. Complete payment must be received no later than 60 days prior to departure. After deposit, all revisions with the exception of adding insurance will be subject to \$25. charge. No changes will be accepted within 6 weeks of departure. Changes that affect inventory utilization (e.g. date change, hotel change, etc.) will be considered a cancellation.

CHANGES: A \$25. fee will be charged for any changes in the reservation that is requested after the original booking has been processed.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS: Payment for this tour program may be made by Discover, Master/Card, Visa or American Express. A surcharge of 3.0% for credit card payments will apply to any charges.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS: Certain commitments for these arrangements have been, or are being made on your behalf in connection with the tour described on the reverse. Naturally, along with these commitments comes a certain responsibility on your part that will necessitate certain cancellation penalties in the event you cancel your tour arrangements prior to the departure date. All notices of cancellation must be received in writing at our office in order to be considered valid. The amount of refund, if any, will be determined by the following schedule in accordance with the date such notice is received: Prior to Nov. 06, 2010: \$45. p.p. Between Nov. 07 & Dec. 06, 2009: \$300.* Between Dec. 07 & Jan. 01: \$400.*; Between Jan. 01 – Feb. 06: \$675.00 *; After Feb. 06, 2011, **Nonrefundable.** (*Plus any further charges assessed by hotels, suppliers and airlines. No shows are non-refundable. Charges indicated are **per person.** In the event that a canceling passenger is able to provide a substitute for that canceled space there will be an administrative charge of \$50. to effect that substitution. All substitutions must follow the same itinerary as the passenger being replaced with the exception that there may be occasions where the substitute may wish to purchase additional options. In this event we will make every effort to satisfy that request.

DOCUMENTS: Documents will be mailed approximately 14 days prior to departure. For bookings received within 30 days of departure you must include an additional \$15. with payment and documents will be sent via overnight delivery. Documents are normally sent by first class mail and become the property of the Participant the moment they are accepted by the U.S.P.S. If desired by the Participant, Holidayze will send the documents by Federal Express upon receipt of \$15 from or on behalf of the Participant.

LAND TRANSPORTATION: Ground transportation, as indicated, will be provided by deluxe motor coaches. In the event of insufficient participation, alternate means of transportation may be provided or offered.

HOTELS/MOTELS: Accommodations will be as indicated except in the case of overbooking. However, the tour operator reserves the right to substitute hotels of a similar category

LIFT TICKETS: Lift tickets are optional and available upon arrival through your local guide.

MEALS: Snacks and meals are served during some flights. Other meals will be as indicated on front page.

TIPPING: All handling charges to hotel staff, porters and chambermaids are included.

BAGGAGE: You are normally allowed 2 pieces of checked baggage plus one carry-on piece that must fit under your seat.
